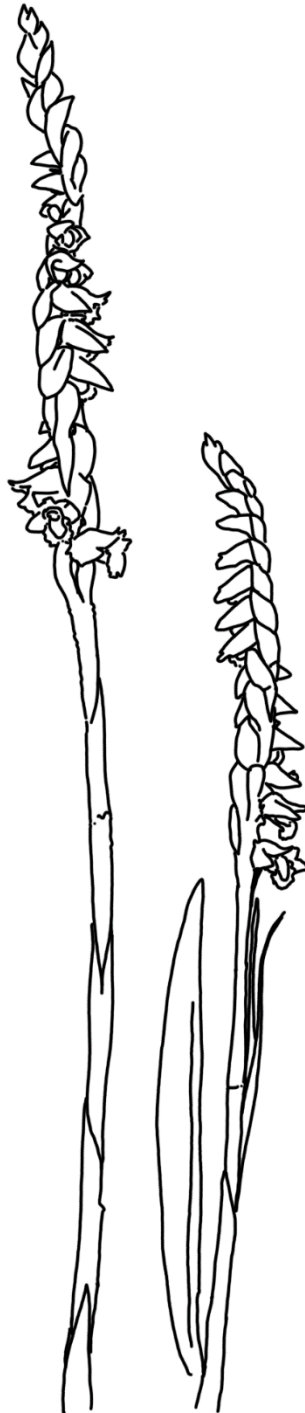


Autumn Ladies Tresses

Spiranthes spiralis

Autumn ladies tresses are found in dry grasslands, meadows and woodlands.

The flowers are white.



They're named because the flowers look like braided hair.

As the name suggests, this orchid flowers in the late summer and autumn.

In the 16th Century autumn ladies tresses were used as a medicine.
