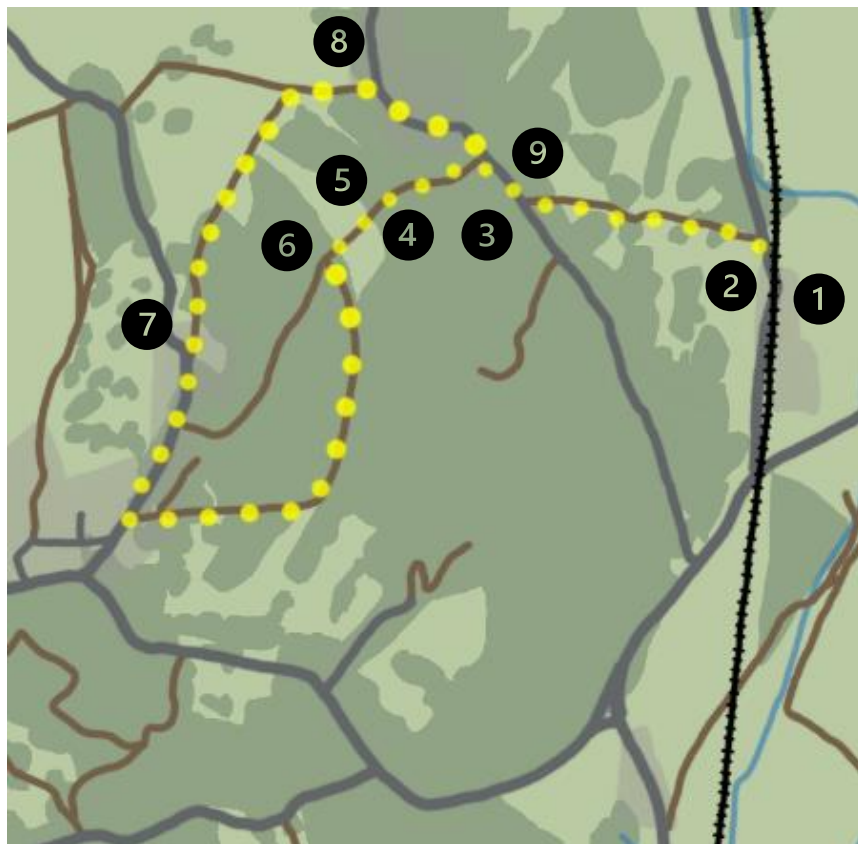


Silverdale: Through the Woods

Route by: Silverdale Parish Council



Distance: approx. 4km (1.5-2 hours).

Start / Finish: Silverdale Railway Station

Accessibility: Mixed terrain, including some narrow gates and styles.

Nearest Public toilets: Near Gaskell Hall.

Nearest Refreshments: RSPB Leighton Moss (nr. Station)

Route:

1. From railway station turn right along road.
2. Turn left across golf course on the footpath (F43) to The Row.
3. Turn right then left along the footpath (F49) past Burton Well.
4. Walk down the steps to Lamberts Meadow
5. Cross the meadow and walk over the stream.
6. Turn left before wall along the footpath (F50) to Bottoms Lane.
7. Turn right then right in along the footpath (F47, joining F46).
8. Turn right to The Row and right again past Burton Well.
9. Continue to the left at the footpath (F43) across the golf course & back to the station.
