This month our volunteers did an excellent job of tidying up a key entrance point to Warton Crag. This disused quarry provides fascinating geology, prime habitat for nesting birds and supports limestone grassland habitats. It is also an unusually large carpark for the AONB which proves to be popular as an entry point. In the carpark we have informative interpretation panels highlighting interesting features and recommended walks around the crag. We got stuck in clearing the growth around the signage and cut back brash around the entrance, allowing for better visibility for people pulling out in their cars. We also did a thorough litter pick within the quarry floor and surrounding area.

I hope all our visitors will agree that the site looks well-kept and inviting. One of the aims of the group is to engage with our community so that locals and visitors alike can enjoy the wonders of Warton Crag.
